**Note:** Pursuant to ORC 3314.20, the enrollment limit of a school is based on the prior year enrollment limit, not the prior year FTE reported by the school. Unless otherwise noted, the initial enrollment base equals the number of students enrolled at the school at the end of 2012 - 2013. The enrollment limit increases by 15% of the prior year limit when the prior year enrollment limit is greater than 3,000. The enrollment limit increases by 25% of the prior year limit when the prior year enrollment limit is less than 3,000. The prior year enrollment limit is different than the FTE reported by the school in the prior year. The enrollment limit of a school will continue to increase at the statutory prescribed percentage, regardless of changes in reported FTE.
