

### EMIS Change 24-103

HB 33 (the budget bill of the 135th General Assembly) requires districts to report the number of students attending a school within the district other than the one normally assigned. Also sets the timing for intradistrict enrollment lotteries.

Between the Attending Building IRN and the Assigned Building Area IRN, districts already report this information to the Department. Therefore, this change will not require changes in reporting. There will be a Manual update to clarify that intradistrict enrollment lotteries are one of the reasons students attend different buildings.

## SECTION 2.4: STUDENT STANDING (FS) RECORD

### ☀ *Assigned Building Area IRN Element*

Record Field Number	FS170
Definition	The IRN of the building the student would normally attend according to the standard district attendance policy.

#### *Valid Options*

Six-digit IRN    Valid building IRN within the reporting district

**Reporting Instructions.** This element will be reported with a non-default value (a value other than “\*\*\*\*\*”) only if it is different from the Attending Building IRN. This IRN is the IRN of the building that the student would normally attend according to district policy, i.e., attendance area. It would be used when the student, for some reason ([e.g., an intradistrict enrollment lottery](#)), is attending the building of the Attending Building IRN instead of the building to which the student would have been assigned.

If the Assigned Building Area IRN is changed, the current student record should be closed. A new Student Standing (FS) Record must be opened and must contain the new IRN.
