<u>215002</u>	<u>Aide Services</u> Support services provided by a qualified aide directly assigned to a child with a disability.
<u>215003</u>	<u>Attendant Services</u> Services include assisting children with disabilities with personal health care needs.
<u>215004</u>	<u>Audiological Services</u> Services provided by a qualified audiologist.
<u>215006</u>	<u>Interpreter Services</u> Services provided by a qualified interpreter to children who are deaf or hard of hearing.
<u>215008</u>	<u>Occupational Therapy Services</u> Services provided by a qualified occupational therapist.
<u>215009</u>	<u>Orientation and Mobility Services</u> Services provided to blind or visually impaired child by a qualified orientation and mobility specialist.
<u>215010</u>	<u>Physical Therapy Services</u> Services provided by a qualified physical therapist.
<u>215012</u>	<u>Psychological Services</u> Services provided by a qualified school psychologist.

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<u>Program Code</u>	<u>Description</u>
<u>215013</u>	<u>Speech and Language Services</u> <u>Services provided by a qualified speech pathologist.</u>
<u>215015</u>	<u>Transition Services</u> <u>Services include those provided by qualified personnel regarding post-secondary transition services (e.g., career development, employment preparation, achieving independence, and integration in the workplace and community).</u>
<u>215018</u>	<u>Counseling Services</u> <u>Services provided by qualified social workers, psychologists, school counselors, or other qualified personnel in accordance with an IEP.</u>
<u>215021</u>	<u>Transportation</u> <u>Transportation established solely for the purpose of transporting students with disabilities attending a regular public school or nonpublic school; travel in and around school buildings; and specialized equipment (such as special or adapted buses, lifts, and ramps), if required to provide special transportation for a child with a disability.</u>
<u>215022</u>	<u>Social Work Services</u> <u>Services provided by a qualified social worker.</u>
<u>215026</u>	<u>School Health Services</u> <u>Services provided by a qualified person other than a school nurse.</u>
<u>215027</u>	<u>School Nurse Services</u> <u>Services provided only by a qualified school nurse.</u>
<u>215030</u>	<u>Board Certified Behavior Analyst Services</u> <u>Services provided by a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA).</u>
<u>215099</u>	<u>Other</u> <u>Services not specifically listed above that are required for students with disabilities to benefit from special education and that are included in the student's IEP. Report this code for services that are needed for a child to access the general curriculum that do not have a specific code.</u>
