# Level 1 Report Explanation: Assessment Missing Reports 

The purpose of this report explanation is to assist districts in reviewing the different Assessment Missing Reports.

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## Assessment Missing Reports

## Function and Purpose

Each entity running a Prepare for any Assessment Collection will receive the Assessment Missing Report for that collection. Assessment Missing Reports are Level 1 reports that can be found in the Data Collector.

Assessment results are expected for all students who fall into any one of the following four groups.

- The student is enrolled during a test administration window,
- The student is reported with a District Relationship of 1,
- The student has assessment result(s) appearing in a vendor file associated with the district, or
- A student is reported with a Sent to Reason of CT, JV, MR, OS, or PI

If a student falls into one of these four groups and does not have an assessment result being reported, then the student will appear on the relevant Assessment Missing Report. Each Assessment Missing Report is for a different assessment. For instance, there is a report for the Childhood Outcome Summary Assessment and a separate report for Other Accountability Assessments. Therefore, the same student can appear on multiple Assessment Missing Reports. See the next section for more information about each available Assessment Missing Report.

These reports can be used by districts to verify which students need assessment results and which students need a Score Not Reported reason. These reports can be used prior to receiving assessment results to troubleshoot students believed to be appearing on the Assessment Missing Report in error and to report Score Not Reported reasons for students you know have not tested and for whom you will not have results.

Assessment Missing Reports have companion Supplementary Reports. The Supplementary Reports contain students who are included in the submission but do not appear on the relevant Assessment Missing Report. Districts should review their Supplementary Reports to ensure that the students on the report should be submitted. If it is determined that all students on the Supplementary Report are valid, then no further action is needed. If it is determined that some students on the Supplementary Report should not be reported for the relevant assessment, then those students' records should be removed from the submission prior to submitting.

To determine whether a particular Assessment Collection is currently generating an Assessment Missing Report, refer to the Release Notes.

If this report explanation-in concert with the EMIS Manual-does not answer your questions or help you to resolve issues with the students who are appearing on your Assessment Missing Reports, then the normal path to getting help with EMIS reporting should be followed. The first point of contact should be the EMIS coordinator, followed by the Information Technology Center, then the EMIS Helpdesk, and finally the Department's EMIS office directly.

## Process Description

Each Assessment Missing Report lists the SSIDs (Statewide Student Identifiers) of students for whom a result is expected but is not being reported. For assessments with multiple subjects, the student appears on the missing list for each missing subject. This data is checked against the test vendor file and the district's enrollment data in order to determine whether a result is being reported.

Data is sorted within the report first by Attending Building IRN and then by Last Name. Each row on the Assessment Missing Report represents a missing assessment subject or area.

## REPORT

## Collections and Records

In general, this report will include the most recently reported data. The records used include the Student Standing (FS), Student Attributes-Effective Date (FD), Course Master (CN), Student Course (GN), Organization-General Information (DN), and Grade Schedule (DL) Records. From these, the elements in Table 1 are used.

## Layout and Fields

The Assessment Missing Report is a Level 1 Report found in the Data Collection within the Preview Prepared Data and on the Reports Tab (see the "Level 1" link near the top of the page). The report name format is Missing_Report_<Assessment/Collection Name>_Assessment_Collection_FY18, where "<Assessment/Collection Name>" is replaced by the name of the assessment collection. For example, Miss-ing_Report_-COS_Spring-Fall_Assessment_Collection_FY18.

## TEST GRADE LEVEL.

TEST DATE. The date the test was administered.
FA STATUS. Student Assessment (FA) Record Status. Every row on the Assessment Missing Report will be assigned a Status. The statuses found on this report are as follows:

- Fatal - there is a Level 1 error preventing data to come through
- Missing - a student assessment record has not been reported by the district
- Missing record reported NOT in the test window. The assessment record matches a missing assessment, but it cannot remove the student from the missing because the test date is not within the current test window. If the record passes validation it will be submitted.
- Valid - the student assessment record has been submitted by the district and meets processing checks

MISSING REASON. Every row on the Assessment Missing Report will be assigned a Missing Reason. The reasons found on this report are as follows:

- Enrolled in test window
- Has vendor test result
- Enrolled in test window and has test result

OTHER PARTICIPATING ASSESSMENTS. This column only appears on the Spring Assessment Missing Lists in the table below. The table lists the possible values for this column along with an explanation of each value. The value depends on whether the student also appears on other Spring Assessment or OELPA Missing Lists. The End of Course Missing List is based on course reporting and vendor files; the Alternate Assessment and OELPA Standard 3-8 Missing Lists are based on student data (student attributes such as grade level, effective start date, end date, and withdrawal reason), special education event reporting, and vendor files.

The value in this column is based on the district's most recent prepare. This value will change or be removed once valid assessment scores or Score Not Reported reasons for the relevant tests have been included in the district's assessment collections. Note that a student could be appearing on the Missing List for multiple test subjects. For example, a student may be on the EOC missing for algebra and American history. "End of Course" will continue to appear in this column until test results or Score Not Reported reasons have been reported for both tests.

It's likely that the Spring Alternate Assessment, which opens first, will contain references to other missing lists that open later, EOC Spring and Spring 3-8. In those cases, the references in the Other Participating Assessments column will not change until changes are made in those later collections.
